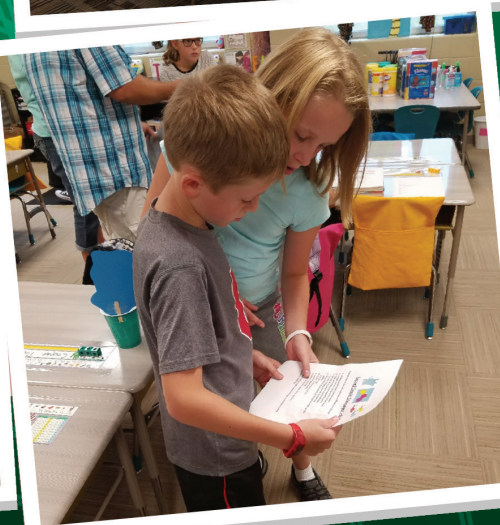
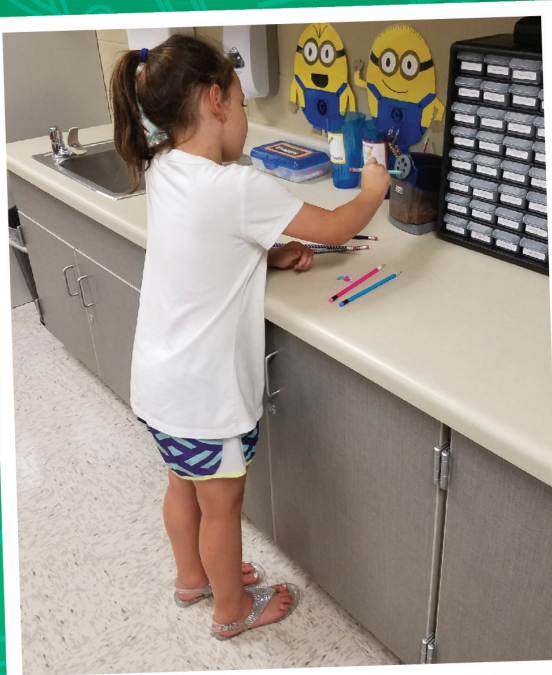

# WELCOME NEW TEACHERS

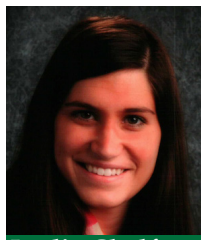


**Lisa Anderson**

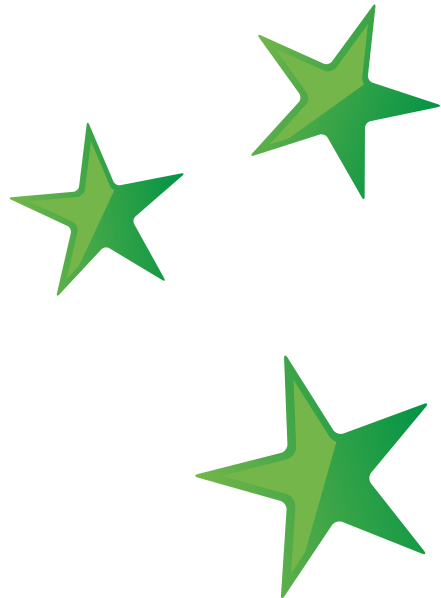
Her family has also been busy this summer playing with their new lab puppy. "I love the W-G community and am looking forward to my new adventure in 1st grade!"

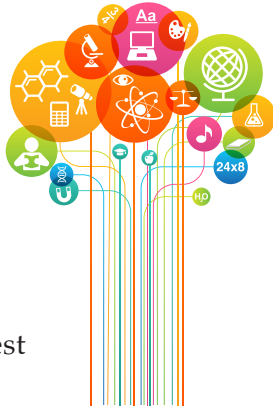
**Felicity David (1st grade Daisy Girl Scout), Sophie David and Joe Boyles (mentor).**
